THE CHARACTER OF THE GOSPEL - 1-7; THE CONCERN FOR THE GOSPEL - 8-15

❖ Seen in the PRAYERS of Paul - 8-12 - v. 9 - "my prayers"

1a. His **Rejoicing** – 8 –

Rom 1:8 First, **I thank my God through Jesus Christ** for **you all**, that your faith is spoken of throughout the whole world. –**cf. Col. 1:6; Acts 28:14-15**

- Cf. 1 Thess. 2:13 "For this reason we also thank God without ceasing..."
 - 1b. Controlled by his personal relationship to God "my God" cf. Ps. 23:1; Phil. 4:19
 - 2b. <u>Came from the access</u> which He had to God "<u>through Jesus Christ</u>" <u>Rom. 5:1-2</u>; Heb. 4:14-16; 10:19ff
 - 3b. Centered in his intercession for them "for you all" cf. Phil. 1:3-4
- 2a. His **Requests** 9-10 -

Rom 1:9 For God is my witness, whom I serve with my spirit in the gospel of His Son, that without ceasing I make mention of you always in my prayers,

Rom 1:10 making request if, by some means, now at last I may find a way in the will of God to come to you.

(Based on four things)

- 1b. Based on his sincerity "For God is my witness" cf. Rom. 9:1
- 2b. Based on <u>his service</u> "whom I <u>serve</u> with <u>my spirit</u> in the <u>gospel of His Son</u> Greek: *latreuo* religious service of priests in the temple an act of worship! *Cf. Rom. 12:1*
 - 1c. It was <u>internal</u>, not external "the inward man" <u>Eph. 6:5-6</u> "doing the will of God from the heart"
 - 2c. It was <u>spiritual</u>, not carnal cf. John 4:24- <u>Gal. 5:13</u> "do not use liberty as an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another"
 - 3c. It was of <u>salvation</u>, <u>not social</u>! "in the gospel of His Son" Col. 3:24 "for you serve the Lord Christ" cf. <u>1 Cor. 2:2</u> <u>The gospel is the issue!</u>
- 3b. Based on his continual supplications in their behalf "without ceasing I make mention of you always in my prayers" Col. 1:3 "praying always for you" 1Thess. 1:2 "making mention of you in my prayers"

- 4b. Based on his <u>submission to the will of God</u> "Making request if, by some means...I may find a way in the will of God to come to you" "if by some means...I may find a way" Greek: euodothesomai Cf. <u>1 Cor. 16:2</u> "as He may prosper" (If we have the money, great if not, <u>we may need to wait</u> on the Lord for His provision.)
- 3a. His **Reasons** 11-12 -

<u>Rom 1:11</u> For I long to see you, that I may impart to you some spiritual gift, so that you may be established--

Rom 1:12 that is, that **I may be encouraged together with you** by the mutual faith both of you and me.

- 1b. To **exercise** a spiritual gift "that I may impart unto you some spiritual gift" (Help me, LORD, to use my spiritual gifts to encourage others!!!)
- 2b. To establish the believers "so that you may be established" Greek: sterixthenai
- 3b, To **encourage** them "*may be encouraged together with you*" (evidence of Paul's humility). Never <u>underestimate the value/importance of encouragement!!</u>

❖ 2. Seen in the PLANS (PURPOSES) of Paul - 13-15 -

Rom 1:13 Now I do not want you to be unaware, brethren, that **I often planned(purposed)** to **come to you** (**but was hindered until now**), that I might have some fruit among you also, just as among the other Gentiles.

Rom 1:14 I am a debtor both to Greeks and to barbarians, both to wise and to unwise.

Rom 1:15 So, as much as is in me, **I am ready to preach** the gospel to you who are in Rome also.

- v. 13 "I often planned to come to you"
- 1a. The **Resistance** to his coming "but was hindered until now"
 - 1b. His **desire** was strong, but unfulfilled v. 11 "For I long to see you"
 - 2b. His decision was made on many occasions, but not yet possible "I often planned to come"
 - 3b. His **determination** was hindered "but was hindered until now"
 - 1c. Hindered by his service in the work of the gospel Rom. 15:20-22
 - 2c. Hindered by sickness 2 Cor. 1:8-10; 12:7-10; Philippians 2:25-30
 - 3c. Hindered by Satan 1 Th. 2:18
 - 4c. Hindered by the Spirit Acts 16:6-7
- 2a. His **Reason** for coming to them -13 Rom 1:13 Now I do not want you to be unaware, brethren, that I often planned to come to you (but was hindered until now), that I might have some <u>fruit</u> among you also, just as among the other Gentiles.
 - "fruit" -
 - 1b. The "fruit" of the **Person** of the Holy Spirit controlling our attitudes *Galatians* 5:22-23
 - 2b. The "fruit" of the practices of holiness controlling our depravity Romans 6:22
 - 3b. The "fruit" of the **people** who come to believe the gospel controlling our priorities <u>Rom.</u> <u>16:5; 1 Cor. 16:15; John 15:16</u>
- 3a. His <u>Responsibility to all men</u> 14 *Rom 1:14 <u>I am a debtor* (Obligated to do something) both to Greeks and to barbarians, both to wise and to unwise.</u>
 - "I am debtor" cf. 1 Cor. 9:19-22 No matter how it is!!! God wants to reach people!
 - 1b. In terms of ethnicity "both to the Greeks, and to the Barbarians"
 - 2b. In terms of **education -** "both to the wise, and to the unwise" Do you feel obligated to all who are lost??
- 4a. His Readiness to preach -15 Rom. 1:15 So, as much as is in me, I am ready to preach the gospel to you who are in Rome also.
- "I am ready to preach the gospel" Acts 20:22-24; 21:13-14; 23:11; 27:22-25; 28:30-31
