- 6A. <u>THE REVELATION OF A MYSTERY 11:25-32</u> "*mystery*" - used 22 times in English; *musterion* - used <u>27 times</u> in Greek.

Rom 11:25 **For I do not desire, brethren, that you should be ignorant of this** <u>mystery,</u> lest you should be wise in your own opinion, <u>that blindness in part has</u> <u>happened to Israel until the fullness of the Gentiles has come in.</u>

1B. The <u>CONCERN of Paul about spiritual and prophetic ignorance</u> - "For I do not desire, brethren, that you should be ignorant..."

- 1C. Ignorant of Messianic prophecies Acts 3:17-18
- 2C. Ignorant of God's purpose in changing circumstances Romans 1:13
- 3C. Ignorant about believers who have died 1 Thess. 4:13-18 The Rapture of the Church
- 4C. Ignorant about the delay in the second coming of Jesus Christ 2 Peter 3:8-9
- 5C. Ignorant about spiritual gifts 1 Cor. 12:1
- 6C. Ignorant about sufferings in the life of the believer 2 Cor. 1:8-9
- 7C. Ignorant about God's plan for Israel Rom. 11:25

2B. The CHARACTER of a biblical mystery (it wasn't understood and still isn't today!)

"For I do not, brethren, that you should be ignorant of this mystery...." that which was not known in the past, but now being revealed. I Cor. 2:7 says "But we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery, even the hidden wisdom, which God ordained before the world unto our glory: which none of the princes of this world knew: for had they known it, they would not have crucified the Lord of glory." Paul spoke in I Cor. 4:1 about being "stewards of the mysteries of God"

1C. The mystery of the kingdom - Matt. 13:11; Mark 4:11-12 & Luke 8:10 (how it will grow)

- 2C. The mystery of the <u>rapture</u> <u>1 Cor. 15:51</u> (folks who are alive and remain will be caught up)
- 3C. The mystery of <u>His will</u> *Eph. 1:9-10* (everything into one under the authority of Christ)

4C. The mystery of <u>Christ</u> - <u>*Eph. 3:3-11*</u>; *Col. 4:3* (both Jew and Gentile brought into one body) 5C. The mystery of <u>marriage</u> - <u>*Eph. 5:32*</u> (what the husband and wife represent)

6C. The mystery of the <u>gospel</u> - <u>*Eph. 6:19*</u> (that through its proclamation, people can be saved) 7C. The mystery of Christ in you - *Col. 1;26-27* (the hope of glory)

8C. The mystery of God - Col. 2:2-3; Rev. 10:7 (all the treasures hidden in Christ)

9C. The mystery of **iniquity** - <u>2 Thess. 2:7</u> (the antichrist himself)

10C. The mystery of the <u>faith</u> - <u>1 Tim. 3:9</u> (men become strong and spiritual leaders)

11C. The mystery of godliness - 1 Tim. 3:16 (that God was in the flesh)

12C. The mystery of the <u>seven stars and the seven candlesticks</u> - <u>*Rev. 1:20* (The seven stars are the ministers of the churches; the seven candlesticks are the seven churches, to whom Christ would now send by Him particular and proper messages)</u>

13C. The mystery of the **harlot woman and the beast** - *<u>Rev. 17:5</u>, 7 (the mystery of who Babylon and the beast are)*

3B. The **CONDITION of Israel**

"that blindness in part is happened to Israel until the fullness of the Gentiles has come in."

1C. It is **Partial** - *"in part"* - *cf.* <u>*Rom.* 11:1-6</u> - <u>illustrated by Paul and Elijah.</u> There have always <u>been Jewish Messianic believers!</u>

2C. It is **Present until the fullness of the Gentiles** - cf. Rom. 11:11-12; Rev. 7:9ff

3C. It is **Prophetic that it would occur** - *Isa. 6:9-10* - Gentiles are also "blinded" - Eph. 4:17-19; <u>2</u> Cor. 4:3-4

Rom 11:26 And <u>so all Israel will be saved, as it is written: "THE DELIVERER</u> <u>WILL COME OUT OF ZION</u>, AND <u>HE WILL TURN AWAY UNGODLINESS</u> <u>FROM JACOB;</u>

4B. The <u>COMING of salvation</u> - "<u>and so all Israel will be saved: as it is written, THE DELIVERER</u> WILL COME OUT OF ZION..."

1C. The Promise -"all Israel" - cf. Zech. 13:8-9

2C. The Person - "the Deliverer" - cf. Isa. 59:20-21; Zech. 12:10

3C. The Purpose - "AND HE WILL TURN AWAY UNGODLINESS FROM JACOB"

Rom 11:27 FOR THIS IS MY COVENANT WITH THEM, WHEN I TAKE AWAY THEIR SINS."

5B. The <u>COVENANT of God</u> - <u>"For this is My covenant with them, when I shall take away their sins"</u> - <u>Jeremiah 31:33-34</u> - cf. <u>Isa. 43:25; 44:21-22; 45:22</u>
