- **#3 - THE RESTORATION OF ISRAEL - Romans 11:1-36**
 - 1A. THE REMNANT IS PROOF - 11:1-6
 - 2A. THE REJECTION WAS PROPHESED - 11:7-10
 - 3A. THE RESULT OF THEIR FALL - 11:11-12
 - 4A. THE RESPONSE THEY WILL HAVE 11:13-16

- **6A. THE REVELATION OF A MYSTERY - 11:25-32**
“mystery” - used 22 times in English; *musterion* - used 27 times in Greek.

Rom 11:25 *For I do not desire, brethren, that you should be ignorant of this mystery, lest you should be wise in your own opinion, that blindness in part has happened to Israel until the fullness of the Gentiles has come in.*

1B. The CONCERN of Paul about spiritual and prophetic ignorance - “*For I do not desire, brethren, that you should be ignorant...*”

- 1C. Ignorant of Messianic prophecies - Acts 3:17-18
- 2C. Ignorant of God’s purpose in changing circumstances - Romans 1:13
- 3C. Ignorant about believers who have died - 1 Thess. 4:13-18 – The Rapture of the Church
- 4C. Ignorant about the delay in the second coming of Jesus Christ – 2 Peter 3:8-9
- 5C. Ignorant about spiritual gifts - 1 Cor. 12:1
- 6C. Ignorant about sufferings in the life of the believer - 2 Cor. 1:8-9
- 7C. Ignorant about God’s plan for Israel - Rom. 11:25

2B. The CHARACTER of a biblical mystery (it wasn’t understood and still isn’t today!)

“*For I do not, brethren, that you should be ignorant of this mystery...*” that which was not known in the past, but now being revealed. *1 Cor. 2:7* says “*But we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery, even the hidden wisdom, which God ordained before the world unto our glory: which none of the princes of this world knew: for had they known it, they would not have crucified the Lord of glory.*” Paul spoke in *1 Cor. 4:1* about being “*stewards of the mysteries of God*”

- 1C. The mystery of the kingdom - Matt. 13:11; Mark 4:11-12 & Luke 8:10 (how it will grow)
- 2C. The mystery of the rapture - 1 Cor. 15:51 (folks who are alive and remain will be caught up)
- 3C. The mystery of His will - Eph. 1:9-10 (everything into one under the authority of Christ)

- 4C. The mystery of Christ - Eph. 3:3-11; Col. 4:3 (both Jew and Gentile brought into one body)
- 5C. The mystery of marriage - Eph. 5:32 (what the husband and wife represent)
- 6C. The mystery of the gospel - Eph. 6:19 (that through its proclamation, people can be saved)
- 7C. The mystery of Christ in you - Col. 1:26-27 (the hope of glory)
- 8C. The mystery of God - Col. 2:2-3; Rev. 10:7 (all the treasures hidden in Christ)
- 9C. The mystery of iniquity - 2 Thess. 2:7 (the antichrist himself)
- 10C. The mystery of the faith - 1 Tim. 3:9 (men become strong and spiritual leaders)
- 11C. The mystery of godliness - 1 Tim. 3:16 (that God was in the flesh)
- 12C. The mystery of the seven stars and the seven candlesticks - Rev. 1:20 (The seven stars are the ministers of the churches; the seven candlesticks are the seven churches, to whom Christ would now send by Him particular and proper messages)
- 13C. The mystery of the harlot woman and the beast - Rev. 17:5, 7 (the mystery of who Babylon and the beast are)

3B. The CONDITION of Israel

"that blindness in part is happened to Israel until the fullness of the Gentiles has come in."

- 1C. It is Partial - "in part" - cf. Rom. 11:1-6 - illustrated by Paul and Elijah. There have always been Jewish Messianic believers!
- 2C. It is Present until the fullness of the Gentiles - cf. Rom. 11:11-12; Rev. 7:9ff
- 3C. It is Prophetic that it would occur - Isa. 6:9-10 - Gentiles are also "blinded" - Eph. 4:17-19; 2 Cor. 4:3-4

Rom 11:26 And so all Israel will be saved, as it is written: "THE DELIVERER WILL COME OUT OF ZION, AND HE WILL TURN AWAY UNGODLINESS FROM JACOB;

4B. The COMING of salvation - "and so all Israel will be saved: as it is written, THE DELIVERER WILL COME OUT OF ZION..."

- 1C. The Promise - "all Israel" - cf. Zech. 13:8-9
- 2C. The Person - "the Deliverer" - cf. Isa. 59:20-21; Zech. 12:10
- 3C. The Purpose - "AND HE WILL TURN AWAY UNGODLINESS FROM JACOB"

Rom 11:27 FOR THIS IS MY COVENANT WITH THEM, WHEN I TAKE AWAY THEIR SINS."

5B. The COVENANT of God - "For this is My covenant with them, when I shall take away their sins" - Jeremiah 31:33-34 - cf. Isa. 43:25; 44:21-22; 45:22
