Rev 1:13 and in the midst of the seven lampstands .(seven churches)

One like the Son of Man,

<u>clothed with a garment down to the feet</u> <u>and girded about the chest with a golden</u> <u>band.</u>

Rev 1:14 <u>His head and hair were white like</u> wool. as white as snow.

I. Notice two things:

Vs. 12-18. THE <u>REVELATION</u> OF OUR RISEN LORD JESUS CHRIST Vs. 19-20. THE <u>RESPONSIBILITY</u> GIVEN TO THE APOSTLE JOHN - 19-20

Vs. 12-18. THE <u>REVELATION</u> OF OUR RISEN LORD JESUS CHRIST - (twelve characteristics-we will look at the first six today!)

Vs. 12-13a. His CENTRALITY

"in the midst of the seven lampstands" -

Cf. 2:1 - "who walks in the midst of the seven golden lampstands"

Cf. 5:6 - "in the midst of the throne and of the four living creatures, and in the midst of the elders, stood a Lamb..."

<u>Matthew 18:20</u> - "For <u>where two or three are gathered together</u> in My name, there am I in the midst of them"

Matthew 28:20 - "lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the age" Col. 1:18 - "and He is the head of the body, the church"

ITi 3:16 And without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: God was manifested in the flesh, Justified in the Spirit, Seen by angels, Preached among the Gentiles, Believed on in the world, Received up in glory.

Hebrews 13:5 - "I will never leave you, nor forsake you"

v. 13b. His HUMANITY - God becoming Man

"One like the Son of Man" - ("like" - homoion - "likeness in external form") - term is used 84 times in the gospels; 21 refer to the second coming; He is the Son of Man! More than just a man! - cf. Daniel 7:13; Matthew 24:30; John 1:14; Phil. 2:5-11. (kenosis-the emptying); Col. 2:9; Is. 9:6

v. 13c. His ROYALTY

"clothed with a garment down to the feet (royalty) and girded about the chest with a golden band" - Clothing of the high priest - Exodus 28:4; 39:29 - Cf. Psalm 93:1; 104:1; Hebrews 3:1, 3; 4:14-16; 7:24-8:1

v. 14a. His PURITY

"His head and hair were white like wool, as white as snow" - Cf. Isa. 1:1; Daniel 7:9. He is called "the Holy One" - cf. Luke 4:34; Acts 2:27; 3:14; Hebrews 7:26;

<u>Do you know what Jesus is like after the</u> resurrection?

We are recognize the centrality of Jesus Christ. <u>Is</u> <u>He truly the center</u> of your life? <u>Is He central in all of your life?</u>

If two or three are gathered together in Jesus' name, His authority is in the midst of them.

We submit to the authority of Jesus Christ-by prayer and obedience to His Word are the principle ways we do this.

The Son of Man is a Messianic term. Jesus is more than mere man. He is both complete man and Divine. He is not like man--He is much more than man; He was in the exact nature and substance of God. When He came into the world as a man, He laid aside His Divine attributes, being in the form of a servant! But we must remember the Mount of Transfiguration! How can we understand this? We can't!--the mystery of the Gospel! An incredible fact—the Gospel- God becoming man!! The incarnation!! He came to die on a cross!

He is our High Priest!! After what order? What an Advocate we have!!!! He sees us holy and blameless because of Jesus' precious shed blood!

We see His purity!! Not David but a future son of David!

### v. 14b. His SCRUTINY

"and His eyes were like a flame of fire" cf. Daniel 10:6: Revelation 2:18, 23; Jer. 17:9-10; 19:12;

### v. 15a. His VICTORY

"And His feet like fine brass, as if refined in a furnace"
Cf. Revelation 2:18; 14:19-20; 19:15; Isaiah 63:1-6; Is. 61:2

You can't hide from Him—He sees it all!

Where is the Lord going to come to earth? Where is Bozrah? The winepress of God! He is going to come in vengeance!!! He is going to judge them and the blood is going to flow! --Divine retribution! *Rev. 6:10*
