

Act 14:27 “Now when they had come and gathered the church together, they reported all that God had done with them, and that He had opened the door of faith to the Gentiles.”

Trip to: Chile, Argentina, Uruguay:

Santiago, Chile – 13 CC’s; stayed at the Bible College/CC in Central Santiago. Encouraged them to stay in prayer; pray for the lost and to know the whole counsel of God.

Buenos Aires, Argentina – two new CC’s there. Pastors from other denominations. Lengthy discussions re division in fellowships; harmony of staff – especially Senior and Assistant pastors. Issues of new church plants.

Montevideo, Uruguay – Bible College/Pastor’s Training from Sergio – former 7th Day Adventist; also has CC Spanish fellowship. Several experienced pastors in Montevideo, being trained in teaching through the Bible.

Mendoza, Argentina - 1st ever CC Pastors conference – primarily focusing on the teaching the Word of God. - verse by verse as opposed to topical. Went through all 6 chapters of 1 Timothy – my session was on chapter 2.

Summary: There are many pastors who are being influenced by CC material, translated into Spanish on the internet. Most often cited are Pastor Chuck’s books, “*Grace Changes Everything*”, “*Living Water*” and “*Calvary Distinctives*”. There is a real interest in some to teach the Word of God, verse by verse, chapter by chapter, but they have had no experience of teaching in this manner and are desirous of learning.
