Pro 1:2 To know wisdom and instruction, To perceive the words of understanding,
Pro 1:3 To receive the instruction of wisdom, Justice, judgment, and equity.
Pro 1:7 The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge, but fools despise wisdom and instruction.

- To fear God, to reverence God, to know God. That is the beginning of knowledge.
- *Pro 2:2 So that you incline your ear to wisdom, And apply your heart to understanding;*
- Pro 2:3 Yes, if you cry out for discernment, And lift up your voice for understanding,
- Pro 2:4 If you seek her as silver, And search for her as for hidden treasures;
- *Pro 2:5 Then you will understand the fear of the LORD, And find the knowledge of God.*
- Pro 2:6 For the LORD gives wisdom; From His mouth come knowledge and understanding;
- Pro 2:7 He stores up sound wisdom for the upright; He is a shield to those who walk uprightly;
- Pro 3:5 Trust in the LORD with all your heart, And lean not on your own understanding;
- *Pro 3:6 In all your ways acknowledge Him, And He shall direct your paths.* Excellent instruction!
- Pro 3:7 Do not be wise in your own eyes; Fear the LORD and depart from evil.
- Pro 3:33 The curse of the LORD is on the house of the wicked, But He blesses the home of the just.
- Pro 4:5 Get wisdom! Get understanding! Do not forget, nor turn away from the words of my mouth.
- Pro 4:6 Do not forsake her (wisdom), and she will preserve you; Love her, and she will keep you.
- Pro 4:7 Wisdom is the principal thing; Therefore get wisdom. And in all your getting, get understanding.
- Pro 4:23 Keep your heart with all diligence (so important), For out of it spring the issues of life.
- Pro 5:15 Drink water from your own cistern, And running water from your own well.

- Pro 5:20 For why should you, my son, be enraptured by an immoral woman, And be embraced in the arms of a seductress? There is no real love there!
- Pro 5:21 For the ways of man are before the eyes of the LORD, And He ponders all his paths.
- Pro 5:22 His own iniquities entrap the wicked man, And he is caught in the cords of his sin.
- Pro 6:6 Go to the ant, you sluggard! Consider her ways and be wise.
- *Pro 6:16 These six things the LORD hates, Yes, seven are an abomination to Him:* 7 things God hates.
- Pro 6:17 A proud look (ever guilty of that?) A lying tongue, Hands that shed innocent blood,
- Pro 6:18 A heart that devises wicked plans, Feet that are swift in running to evil,
- Pro 6:19 A false witness who speaks lies, And one who sows discord among brethren.
- Pro 7:21 With her enticing speech she caused him to yield, With her flattering lips she seduced him.
- Pro 7:22 Immediately he went after her, as an ox goes to the slaughter, Or as a fool to the correction of the stocks, (it ends up in death!)
- Pro 8:7 For my mouth will speak truth; Wickedness is an abomination to my lips.
- Pro 8:8 All the words of my mouth are with righteousness; Nothing crooked or perverse is in them.
- **Pro 8:13** The fear of the LORD (14x in Prov; 27 x in Bible) is to hate evil; Pride and arrogance and the evil way And the perverse mouth I hate.
- Pro 8:14 Counsel is mine, and sound wisdom; I am understanding, I have strength.
- Pro 8:15 By me kings reign, And rulers decree justice.
- *Pro 9:10 ''The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom, And the knowledge of the Holy One* (knowing God) *is understanding.* Do you want to be wise? Have that holy fear of God!
- *Pro 9:11 For by me your days will be multiplied, And years of life will be added to you.*
- *Pro 10:2 Treasures of wickedness* (wickedness 11x; wicked 13x) *profit nothing, But righteousness* (righteousness 21x; righteous 16x) *delivers from death.*
- Pro 10:27 The fear of the LORD prolongs days, But the years of the wicked will be shortened.
- *Pro 10:30 The righteous* (of Jesus Christ) *will never be removed, But the wicked will not inhabit the earth.*

Pro 11:4 Riches do not profit in the day of wrath, But righteousness delivers from death.

- Pro 11:5 The righteousness of the blameless will direct his way aright, But the wicked will fall by his own wickedness.
- **Pro 11:6** The righteousness of the upright will deliver (guides) them, But the unfaithful will be caught by their lust.
- Pro 11:13 A talebearer reveals secrets, But he who is of a faithful spirit conceals a matter.
- Pro 11:14 Where there is no counsel, the people fall; But in the multitude of counselors there is safety.
- Pro 11:22 As a ring of gold in a swine's snout, So is a lovely woman who lacks discretion.
- Pro 12:4 An excellent wife is the crown (seen) of her husband, But she who causes shame is like rottenness (unseen) in his bones.
- Pro 12:7 The wicked are overthrown and are no more, But the house of the righteous will stand.
- Pro 12:12 The wicked covet the catch of evil men, But the root of the righteous yields fruit.
- Pro 12:22 Lying lips are an abomination to the LORD, But those who deal truthfully are His delight.
- *Pro 13:9 The light of the righteous rejoices* (brings joy), *But the lamp of the wicked will be put out.* So righteous and wicked again. How much light is coming out of my life?
- *Pro 13:10 By pride comes nothing but strife, But with the well-advised is wisdom* (learn by listening).
- Pro 13:11 Wealth gained by dishonesty will be diminished, But he who gathers by labor will increase.
- Pro 13:12 Hope deferred makes the heart sick, But when the desire comes, it is a tree of life.
- Pro 13:24 He who spares his rod hates his son, But he who loves him disciplines him promptly.
- Pro 14:4 Where no oxen are, the trough is clean; But much increase comes by the strength of an ox.
- Pro 14:12 There is a way that seems right to a man, But its end is the way of death.
- Pro 14:26 In the fear of the LORD there is strong confidence, And His children will have a place of refuge.
- Pro 14:27 The fear of the LORD is a fountain of life, To turn one away from the snares of death.

Pro 14:34 Righteousness exalts a nation, But sin is a reproach to any people.

- Pro 15:1 A soft answer turns away wrath, But a harsh word stirs up anger.
- Pro 15:23 A man has joy by the answer of his mouth, And a word spoken in due season (timely), how good it is!
- Pro 15:28 The heart of the righteous studies how to answer, But the mouth of the wicked pours forth evil.
- Pro 15:29 The LORD is far from the wicked, But He hears the prayer of the righteous.
- Pro 15:33 The fear of the LORD is the instruction of wisdom, And before honor is humility.
- *Pro 16:3 Commit your works to the LORD, And your thoughts will be established.* An important proverb.
- Pro 16:9 A man's heart plans his way, But the LORD directs his steps. God is in control.
- Pro 16:31 The silver-haired head is a crown of glory, If it is found in the way of righteousness.
