

GOD SAID, "I WILL" -- HIS COVENANT WITH ABRAHAM AND ISAAC -- GEN. 17

Gen 17:1 When Abram was ninety-nine years old, the LORD appeared to Abram and said to him, "I am Almighty God; walk before Me and be blameless.

Questions:

- Are you presently experiencing something, really big, that you just can't seem to get over or to get past, that is holding you back? A real thorn in the flesh, so to speak, that if you could only get past it, not only would your life be so much better, but your ministry focus could be so improved?
- Do you believe that God is faithful – ALWAYS? Do you really believe He will lead you through all the way?
- Do you believe that your name is written in the Book of Life? Are you sure? Why?
- Do you have less faith that He will lead you all the way through your present situation?
- How thankful are you that we have a covenant keeping God?

Gen 17:2 And I will make My covenant between Me and you, and will multiply you exceedingly."

Gen 17:6 I will make you exceedingly fruitful; and I will make nations of you, and kings shall come from you.

Gen 17:7 And I will establish My covenant between Me and you and your descendants after you in their generations, for an everlasting covenant, to be God to you and your descendants after you.

Gen 17:8 Also I give to you and your descendants after you the land in which you are a stranger, all the land of Canaan, as an everlasting possession; and I will be their God."

Gen 17:16 And I will bless her and also give you a son by her; then I will bless her, and she shall be a mother of nations; kings of peoples shall be from her."

Gen 17:19 Then God said: "No, Sarah your wife shall bear you a son, and you shall call his name Isaac; I will establish My covenant with him (Isaac) for an everlasting covenant, and with his descendants after him.

Gen 17:20 And as for Ishmael, I have heard you. Behold, I have blessed him, and will make him fruitful, and will multiply him exceedingly. He shall beget twelve princes, and I will make him a great nation.

Gen 17:21 But My covenant I will establish with Isaac, whom Sarah shall bear to you at this set time next year."

SUMMARY

- Was God faithful in all His covenants with Abraham, Isaac and Jacob?

- **Gen 17:21 (Abraham)** *But My covenant I will establish with Isaac, whom Sarah shall bear to you at this set time next year."*
- **Gen 28:15 (Jacob)** *Behold, I am with you and will keep you wherever you go, and will bring you back to this land; for I will not leave you until I have done what I have spoken to you."*
- **Exo 2:24 (Moses)** *So God heard their groaning, and God remembered His covenant with Abraham, with Isaac, and with Jacob.*
- **Jos 23:14 (Joshua)** *"Behold, this day I am going the way of all the earth. And you know in all your hearts and in all your souls **that not one thing has failed of all the good things which the LORD your God spoke concerning you. All have come to pass for you; not one word of them has failed.***
- **Zep 3:5** *The LORD is righteous in her midst, He will do no unrighteousness. Every morning He brings His justice to light; **He never fails, But the unjust knows no shame***
- **Heb 13:5 (Moses/Joshua – Dt. 31:6)** *Let your conduct be without covetousness; be content with such things as you have. For He Himself has said, **"I WILL NEVER LEAVE YOU NOR FORSAKE YOU."***
- **Rom 8:32** *He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, **how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things?***
