<u>Psalm 67</u> is often referred to as Israel's missionary Psalm, which expresses the heart of God and the concern for God for the whole wide world, to come and know Him. As Christians, it is recognized that God loves us individually, that God wanted to save each one of us. We understand His heart for the whole world. What He has done in our lives, He wants that in every human life. The LORD has given us a Great Commission, to make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all things! Realizing what He has done for us, how can we keep that a secret to ourselves? We have the same concern, the Holy Spirit in us, to let the whole world know that what He has done in us, He will do in anyone! We are living proof of that. If He can save us, He can save anyone!

<u>PSALM 67</u> – Make Your Face Shine upon Us - To the Chief Musician. On Stringed Instruments. A Psalm. A Song

Psa 67:1. God be merciful to us and bless us, And cause His face to shine upon us, Selah

- A shining face is a happy face! A countenance that is favorably pleased with what it is seeing!
- The Priestly, Aaronic Blessing: Num 6:22-27 And the LORD spoke to Moses, saying: [23] "Speak to Aaron and his sons, saying, 'This is the way you shall bless the children of Israel. Say to them: [24] "The LORD bless you and keep you; [25] The LORD make His face shine upon you, And be gracious to you; [26] The LORD lift up His countenance upon you, And give you peace." [27] "So they shall put My name on the children of Israel, and I will bless them."

Psa 67:2 That Your way may be known on earth, Your salvation among all nations.

• Bless us spiritually, LORD. Prosper us materially! Get the attention of the world that they may see how great it is! How wonderful it is to walk with You. *That Your way may be known on earth and Your salvation among all the nations*. That they may recognize that You are the same God. They can take this back to their own land and know that what You have done to save us, You will do also for them!

Psa 67:3 Let the peoples praise You, O God; Let all the peoples praise You.

- Here is the Psalmist's concern for the whole world, to love the LORD and to be praising the LORD. Psa 67:4 Oh, let the nations be glad and sing for joy! For You shall judge the people righteously, And govern (comfort) the nations on earth. Selah
 - The Psalmist's desire that he has within his heart, that the whole world would know God and worship the LORD. That is going to happen someday. Although the Psalmist would not have clearly known, the Millennial reign of Christ is coming into reality!
 - Imagine a world where everyone is worshiping and praising the LORD! Not one person will disobey the LORD!

Psa 67:5 Let the peoples praise You, O God; Let all the peoples praise You.

Psa 67:6 Then the earth shall yield her increase; God, our own God, shall bless us.

• During the Millennial reign, there will be no more competition between world leaders, taking the food money and resources for their own gain! Then this earth can readily feed everyone! No overpopulation

problem, which only results from a lack of Godly leadership and Godly citizenry! Once that's in place, this world will transform in a way that we can't even imagine – and that isn't even heaven yet! That's all going to happen during that Kingdom Age. (Is. 2:4; 35:1-7; Mic. 4:3-4; Zech. 3:10)!
