***Luk 21:25 "And there will be signs in the sun, in the moon, and in the stars; and on the earth
distress of nations, with perplexity, the sea and the waves roaring;***

***Luk 21:26 men's hearts failing them from fear and the expectation of those things which are
coming on the earth, for the powers of the heavens will be shaken.***

Luk 21:27 Then they will see the Son of Man coming in a cloud with power and great glory.

***Luk 21:28 Now when these things begin to happen, look up and lift up your heads, because your
redemption draws near."***

Watch Yourselves

***Luk 21:34 "But take heed to yourselves, lest your hearts be weighed down with carousing,
drunkenness, and cares of this life, and that Day come on you unexpectedly.***

Luk 21:35 For it will come as a snare on all those who dwell on the face of the whole earth.

***Luk 21:36 Watch therefore, and pray always that you may be counted worthy to escape all these
things that will come to pass, and to stand before the Son of Man."***

Institution of the Lord's Supper

Luk 22:14 When the hour had come, He sat down, and the twelve apostles with Him.

***Luk 22:15 Then He said to them, "With fervent desire I have desired to eat this Passover with you
before I suffer;***

Luk 22:16 for I say to you, I will no longer eat of it until it is fulfilled in the kingdom of God."

***Luk 22:17 Then He took the cup, and gave thanks, and said, "Take this and divide it among
yourselves;***

***Luk 22:18 for I say to you, I will not drink of the fruit of the vine until the kingdom of God
comes."***

***Luk 22:19 And He took bread, gave thanks and broke it, and gave it to them, saying, "This is My
body which is given for you; do this in remembrance of Me."***

***Luk 22:20 Likewise He also took the cup after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in
My blood, which is shed for you.***

Jesus Prays on the Mount of Olives

Luk 22:39 Coming out, He went to the Mount of Olives, as He was accustomed, and His disciples also followed Him.

Luk 22:40 When He came to the place, He said to them, "Pray that you may not enter into temptation."

Luk 22:41 And He was withdrawn from them about a stone's throw, and He knelt down and prayed,

Luk 22:42 saying, "Father, if it is Your will, take this cup away from Me; nevertheless not My will, but Yours, be done."

Luk 22:43 Then an angel appeared to Him from heaven, strengthening Him.

Luk 22:44 And being in agony, He prayed more earnestly. Then His sweat became like great drops of blood falling down to the ground.

Luk 22:45 When He rose up from prayer, and had come to His disciples, He found them sleeping from sorrow.

Luk 22:46 Then He said to them, "Why do you sleep? Rise and pray, lest you enter into temptation."

The Thief on the Cross

Luk 23:42 Then he said to Jesus, "Lord, remember me when You come into Your kingdom."

Luk 23:43 And Jesus said to him, "Assuredly, I say to you, today you will be with Me in Paradise."

The Death of Jesus

Luk 23:44 Now it was about the sixth hour, and there was darkness over all the earth until the ninth hour.

Luk 23:45 Then the sun was darkened, and the veil of the temple was torn in two.

Luk 23:46 And when Jesus had cried out with a loud voice, He said, "Father, 'INTO YOUR HANDS I COMMIT MY SPIRIT.' " Having said this, He breathed His last.

Luk 23:47 So when the centurion saw what had happened, he glorified God, saying, "Certainly this was a righteous Man!"
